A Service experience (Maximum 80 marks)	Active Service Period in Grade I (Class1) (6 marks per year) Marks will be awarded for the active service period of service in the Grade I (Class I) of the Sri Lanka Agricultural Service, excluding the required minimum qualification of 5 years service in Grade I (Class I) of Sri Lanka Agricultural Service No pay leave in any form will be deducted in calculating active service period
B Merits Marks will be awarded through a structured interview (Maximum 20 marks)	B i. Contribution to Agricultural Research & Development (Maximum 15 marks) Contribution to Farm Development/Technology Development/Curriculum development/Project handling/Coordination of International or National projects/Special achievements in Agriculture development programmes/ICT initiatives/Variety release/ Successful handling of Emergency situations (At the rate of maximum 01 mark per event. Documentary evidence should be submitted)
	B ii. Publications (Maximum 05 marks) Publications in refereed journals/ Publications in non refereed journals/ Publication of training Modules/ Publication of curriculums/ Published abstracts /Publication of books/ Publication of training materials/ Technical publications in proceedings, newsletters, Magazines / Interactive CDs, Web publications (At the rate of maximum 01 mark per each . Documentary evidence should be submitted)

Note : In case of A (Active Service Period) for less than one year and more than six months of service experience, half of the marks per year will be given. Period less than six months will not be considered
