Promotion to Special Grade of Sri Lanka Animal Production and Health Service - 2024

Applications are invited from eligible officers in Grade I of the Sri Lanka Animal Production and Health Service to fill the vacancies that exist in 04 posts in Special Grade of the Sri Lanka Animal Production and Health Service for the promotion of officers as per the provisions of the new Service Minute of Sri Lanka Animal Production and Health Service published in the Gazette No.1840/51 dated 13.12.2013 of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka.

02. Salary Scale

According to Schedule I of the Public Administration Circular 03/2016 dated 25.02.2016, the monthly salary scale for this post is Rs.88,000-12X2,700-120,400(SL-3-2016).

03. General Qualifications to be fulfilled

03.1 Having completed an active and satisfactory service period of eighteen (18) years in Sri Lanka Animal Production and Health Service prior to the closing date of calling applications.

03.2 Having completed an active and satisfactory service period of five (05) years in Grade I of Sri Lanka Animal Production and Health Service and earned five (05) increments after promotion to Grade I prior to the closing date of calling applications.

03.3 Should have attained a performance at satisfactory level or above within the period of five (05) years immediately preceding the closing date of calling applications.

03.4 Should not have been subjected to disciplinary punishment in terms of the provisions stipulated in the Public Service Commission Circular No.01/2020

03.5 Should have passed the relevant Efficiency Bar Examinations and fulfilled the relevant training requirements of the officers in Grade I.

04. Accordingly, applications are invited in accordance with the specimen form annexed herewith in respect of promotion of officers to fill vacancies in the said posts and all eligible officers who have fulfilled all required qualifications as at the closing date of calling applications may apply for these posts. Such applications and the relevant documents should be sent before the closing date of calling application i.e. 03.10.2024 along with the recommendation of the Head of the institution by the registered post to the following address. Only the applicants who have satisfied the required qualifications will be summoned for a structured interview conducted by the Public Service Commission and the officers scoring the highest marks at the interview will be promoted to Special Grade in accordance with the number of existing vacancies.
