Integrated Rurban Development and Climate Resilience Project (**IRDCRP**) is a project to be implemented under the Ministry of Agriculture, Livestock, Land & Irrigation, jointly funded by the Government of Sri Lanka (**GOSL**) and the World Bank (**WB**). The total project cost is US\$ 103 Million, and it is designed to support small and medium-scale holdings in sub-sectors: Agriculture, Livestock, Fisheries and Plantation, for addressing identified lapses along the value chain in farm to folk. The main objective of this 05 years project is to improve productivity, competitiveness and climate resilience of agri-food producers in the project areas.

- ii. Having passed three subjects (other than the General Paper) at the G.C.E. (A/L) examination.
