The total project cost is US\$ 103 Million, and it is designed to support small and medium-scale holdings in sub-sectors: Agriculture, Livestock, Fisheries and Plantation, for addressing identified lapses along the value chain in farm to folk. The main objective of this 05 years project is to improve productivity, competitiveness and climate resilience of agri-food producers in the project areas.

Applications are invited from citizens of Sri Lanka to fill the following position on a contract basis for the Project Management Unit (PMU). Basic Qualifications

1. Educational:

Shall have passed at G.C.E (O/L) examination in six subjects at least with two credit passes including Sinhala/Tamil language at not more than two sitting.

2. Technical Skills:

Shall have a heavy vehicle driving license issued by the Commissioner General of Motor Traffic and a minimum of three (03) years of experience after obtaining the driving license.

3. Age :-

- Should be not less than 18 years of age.
- Shall be not more than 50 years of age

2. Ability to communicate in English

- Experience working in a foreign-funded project.
- Willingness to engage in field duties as required by the project.
- Knowledge of government rules and regulations is required.
